## MB101 Historical and Modern commemorative, art medals Thursday 27 January 2022, 12 noon

Our medal auction this time is a little slimmer than usual. This is because of health issues back in August - and yes, Howard is continuing to make a good recovery. Nevertheless despite the reduced size of our offer, this is an interesting sale with some very covetable pieces which although inexpensive are definitely worth looking at and adding to your collection.

We begin with a collection of school and prize medals, many of which are early engraved pieces. Engraved pieces have several points of interest: their hallmarks, their social interest (many of the recipients are girls and women) and their local significance. And as always there's the possibility of researching the people involved.

These are followed by a small collection of so-called love tokens, usually made by smoothing a coin and then engraving a motto, an image, a pledge. We particularly like the cherub sitting on a barrel brandishing a bottle and a glass - it's for a christening! The condition of all these token medals is very fine and better - hard to grade in the numismatic sense as the underlying coin is obliterated and this is 'naive' yet skilled art.

As usual we proceed with the British medals, including the BAMS (British Art Medal Society) issues. Here's a mixed bag with some great pieces - do go online and look at the photos. There are crossovers internationally, including the magnificent medal for the Indian rajah by Lilian Vereker Hamilton. Finally, we have a section on medals from around the world, from Austria to the United States via France, Japan and Malaysia.

All bidding will be done online with the usual closing time from 12 noon. You will need to register to bid and give yourself a user name (this is masked with first and last characters only shown). While you need to provide a debit or credit card to register, when you purchase from us you will have other options for payment. From the 'My Account' section you will be able to see what bids you're winning or losing, and can view your 'watch' list too. Please be sure to add our email address to your contacts (otherwise alerts from us may not reach you or end up in your junk folder).

\*\*\* If you do not have access to the internet, we can bid on your behalf as long as we receive instructions in the post or by email early, so you won't lose out with the new system. However, it is much, much better all round if you bid online because we can't update your bids at the last minute.

Increments: In the future bids will increase in the following way:

£1-£20 £1 increments

£20-£40 £2 increments

£40-£100 £5 increments

£100 onwards £10 increments.

The auction uses proxy bidding so that you only see the current winning bid, not someone's maximum bid (think eBay). There won't be tied bids in the future - if someone else has bid your maximum before you, they win unless we have your instruction to increase your bid by a set number of increments e.g. 1 or 2 bids. There's no third party sniping facility but of course you can bid online up to (almost) the closing time online. Be aware though that once the auction has started calculating winning bids from 12 noon onwards you may not be able to place last minute bids. You will get an alert by email for lots won; at that point go to 'My Account' and checkout 'bids won'. That then creates an order and gives you options to pay. Please note that there may be extra postage charged afterwards for heavy items such as books or large cast medal - it depends on the destination, choice of carrier and just how heavy the items are.

**THERE IS NO BUYER'S PREMIUM** As we've not resolved the issues with the automatic generation of invoices from the website adding the premium, we've decided to do away with it and sacrifice some profit for the sake of sanity.

The price online is the reserve if no bids registered. We reckon this is roughly half estimated price

(thank you!) The post is still unreliable so bid early if offline.

The first price in the catalogue is the reserve as well as the starting price (same online); bids will be refused below this.
